

INTERSTATE 35 COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
SPECIAL BOARD MEETING MINUTES
March 30, 2021

The Interstate 35 Community School District Board of Education met in special session, at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 30, 2021 at the District Office Conference Room in Truro, Iowa.

President Jeremy Maske (attending virtually) called the meeting to order at 7:03 a.m. Directors Roger Cannoy, Cindi Cassady, and Eddie Vonnahme were virtually present. Director Sara Hughes was present physically with Superintendent Mrs. Sharon Dentlinger and Board Secretary Ted Bauer. All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance and Maske read I-35's District Mission Statement and the District's Priorities.

Motion by Cannoy, seconded by Vonnahme to approve the agenda as presented; motion carried 5-0.

Maske called for discussion and approval of the following consent agenda items: Resignations from Rick Cowden (custodian), Whitney Siefkas (ms language arts teacher); contracts for Ethan Adair (custodian), Whitney Siefkas (talented and gifted teacher), Alexander Coleman (hs science teacher); reductions in hours from full time to part time for William Bubany (custodian). Motion by Hughes, seconded by Cassady to approve the consent agenda items as presented; motion carried 5-0.

Mrs. Dentlinger presented the tentative agreement with the Interstate 35 Education Association. It includes advancement on step (aging the schedule), adding \$550 to the base, resulting in a 2.81% salary increase. Motion by Cassady, seconded by Cannoy to approve the tentative agreement with the Interstate 35 Education Association; motion carried 5-0.

Dentlinger explained that state operational sharing dollars are available to provide for a college and career transition counselor to work part-time in our district. Dentlinger recommended the district enter into a 28E agreement with DMACC and Van Meter CSD to share a College and Career Transition Counselor for three years beginning on July 1, 2021. The Counselor would work part-time (40 percent during the school year) at I-35 CSD in coordination with the High School Guidance Counselor. Motion by Hughes, seconded by Vonnahme to approve the 28E Agreement for a College and Career Transition Counselor shared with DMACC and Van Meter CSD; motion carried 5-0.

The next regular board meeting is scheduled for April 22, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. at the High School Media Center in Truro.

Motion by Cannoy, seconded by Cassady to adjourn; motion carried 5-0. Meeting adjourned at 7:30 a.m.
