

INTERSTATE 35 COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
WORK SESSION MEETING MINUTES
April 6, 2020

The Interstate 35 Community School District Board of Education held a work session on Monday, April 6, at 5:00 p.m. in the High School Media Center in Truro, Iowa and Electronically.

President Jeremy Maske called the virtual meeting to order at 5:03 p.m. Directors Roger Cannoy, Cindi Cassady, Sara Hughes were virtually present. Vice-President Eddie Vonnahme was not virtually present until after the meeting started. Also virtually present was Superintendent Mrs. Sharon Dentlinger. Board Secretary Ted Bauer was at the school and attended virtually. Members of the public were also invited to attend the virtual meeting via Zoom due to Governor Reynold's resolution to have no more than 10 people in a gathering.

Motion by Cannoy, seconded by Cassady to approve the agenda; motion carried 4-0.

Mrs. Dentlinger presented the Continuous Learning Plan with the board members and the public. If approved, the plan would go into effect on April 13 and would include transitioning grades 9-12 to Required Education Services and grades PK-8 would continue to receive Voluntary Educational Enrichment Activities.

Support Staff-wages through April 30: Because the work session had gone past the posted time for the start of the special board meeting set for 5:45 p.m. and because this item was also on the special meeting's agenda, the board decided to discuss this agenda item at that time.
