The Interstate 35 Community School District Board of Education held a work session on Monday, April 20, at 5:15 p.m. in the High School Media Center in Truro, Iowa and Electronically.

The work session was held to discuss scheduled events that will need to be altered, cancelled, or postponed due to the school closure through the end of the 2019-2020 school year by Governor Reynolds. Mrs. Dentlinger, Mr. Kaster, and the board members discussed the following events: Prom, Spring Musical, Awards Night, Fine Arts Night, Senior Signing Day, 9th Grade Orientation, Financial Aid Night, and Graduation. No action was taken during the work session. The Administration will be making recommendations to the Board at the next regular board meeting on April 27.

The Board further discussed adding a 360 Degree Evaluation Review to gather feedback for the Superintendent's evaluation. After a lengthy discussion, the Board formed a committee consisting of Roger Cannoy, Cindi Cassady, and Eddie Vonnahme to bring a survey and process to the special board meeting on May 11, so that the survey can be completed in May and the evaluation completed in June.

Maske adjourned the work session at 6:54 p.m.
